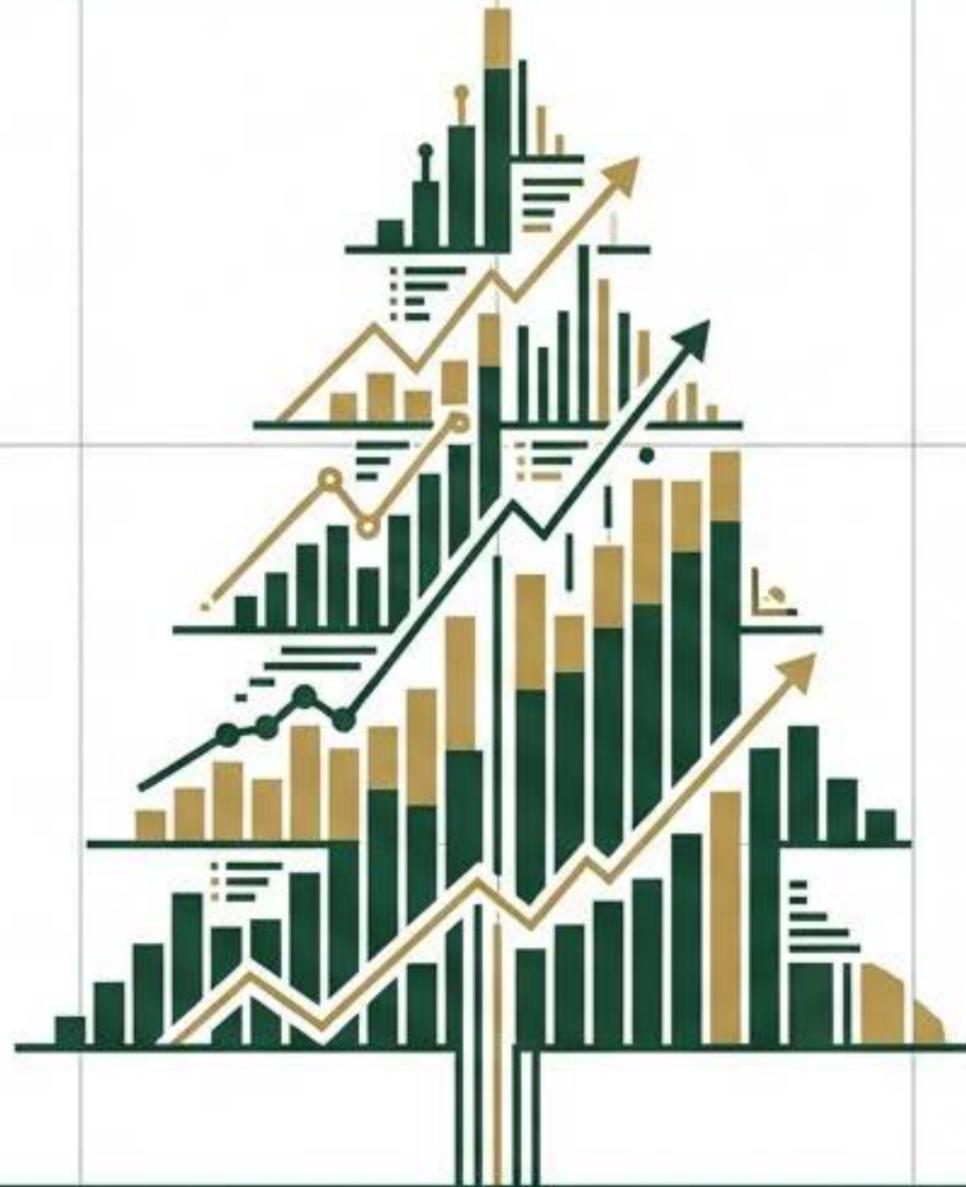


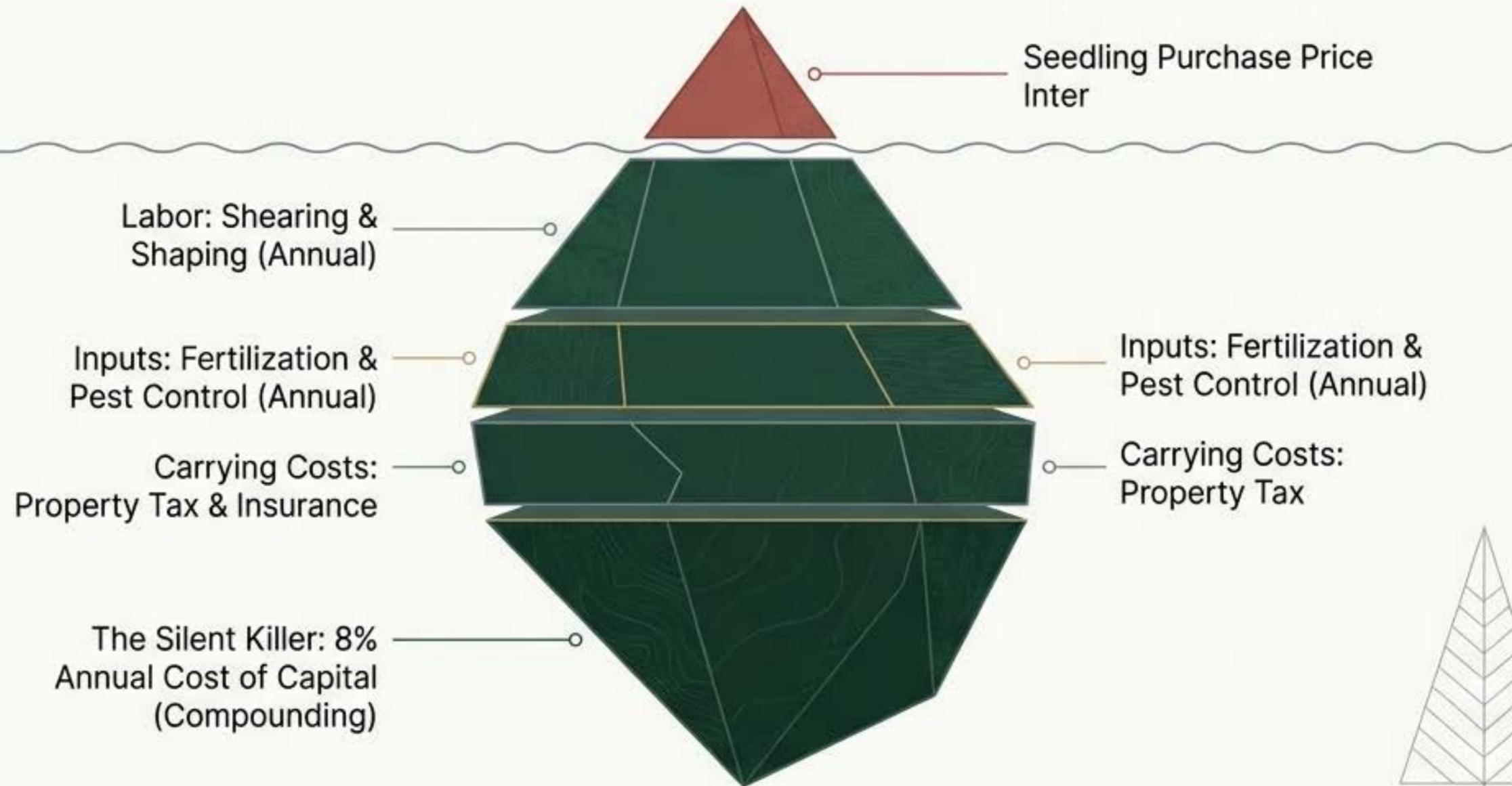

The True Cost of Goods Sold: Capitalizing the 8-Year Cycle

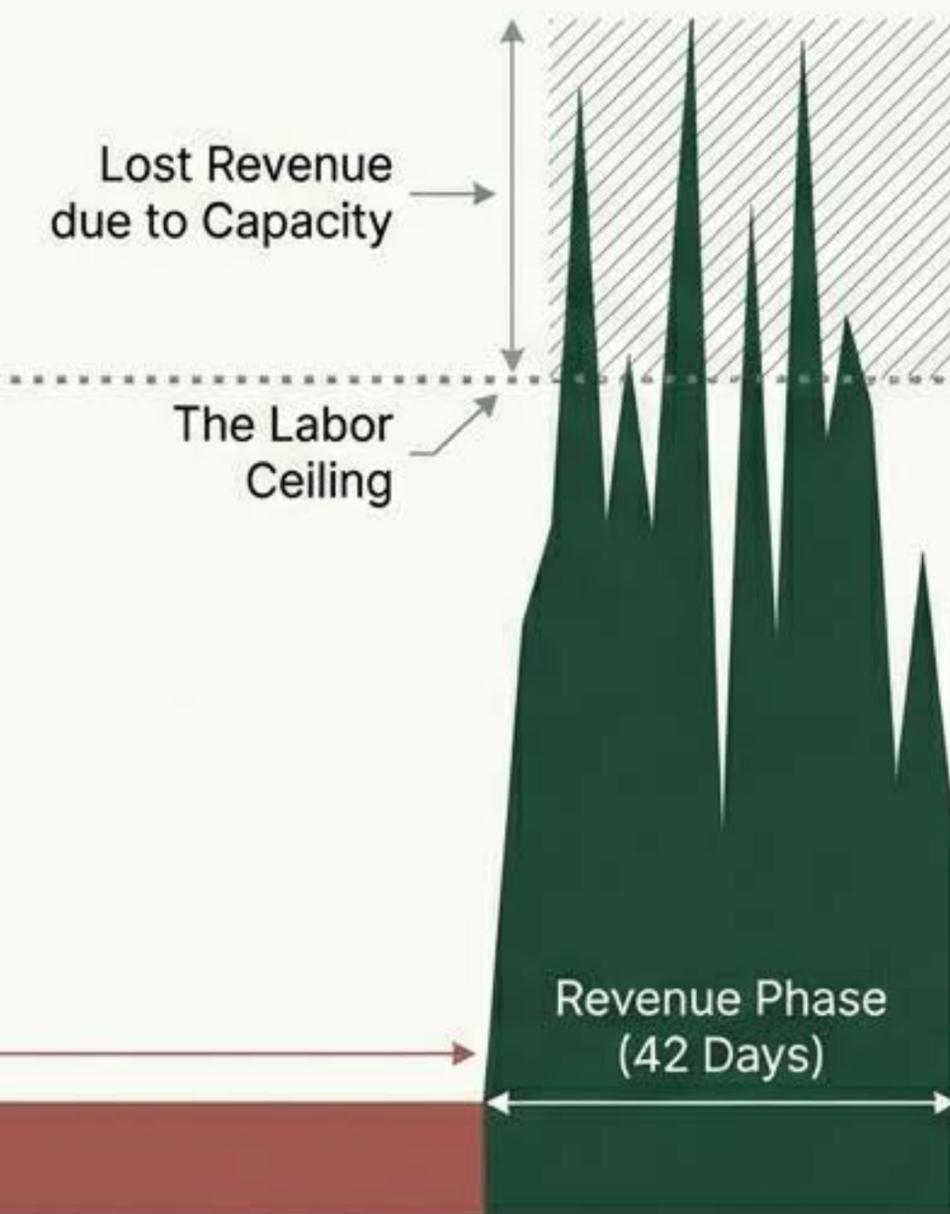


Standard inventory accounting fails here. You aren't buying a seedling; you are capitalizing 8 years of risk before the first dollar of revenue arrives.

The 'November Crush' Paradox

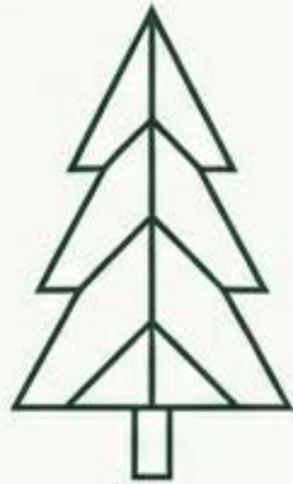
42 Days:

“If you staff for 80% capacity, you lose 20% of peak sales.”

Strategy 1: Optimizing the Crop Mix for Revenue Per Acre

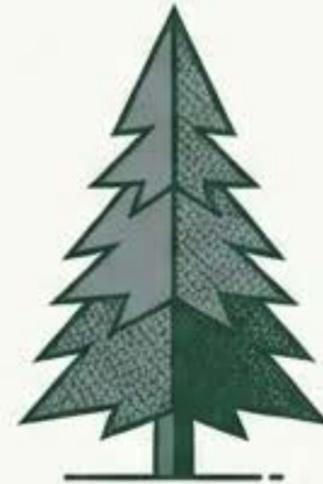


White Pine (Legacy)

\$500 / unit

8-Year Maturity

Low Maintenance



Blue Spruce

\$640 / unit

10-Year Maturity

Cash Flow Delay Risk



Fraser Fir (Strategic)

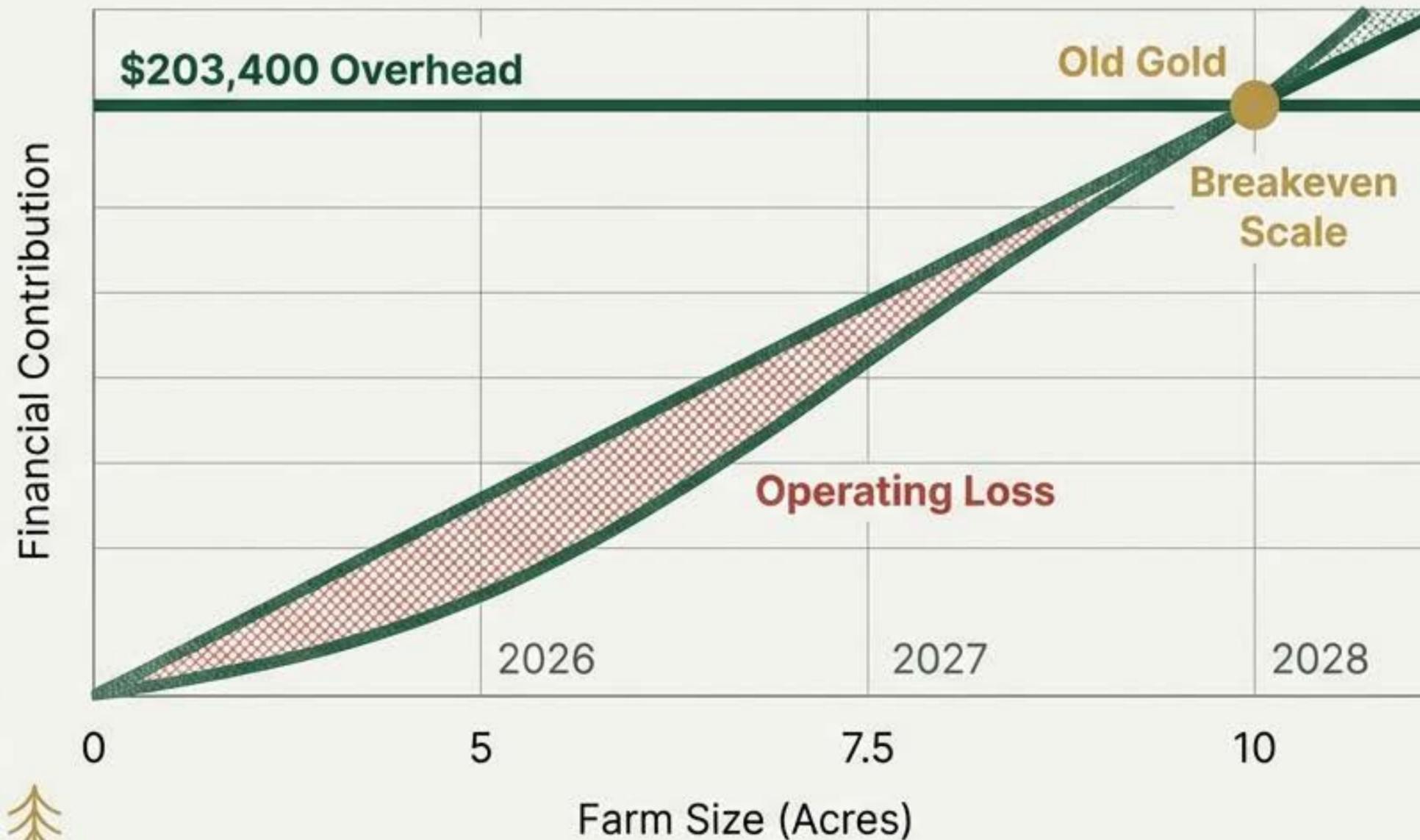
\$700 / unit

High Maintenance

+\$2.00/year shearing cost

Shifting just 10% of acreage to premium varieties lifts revenue per acre by 5–10%.

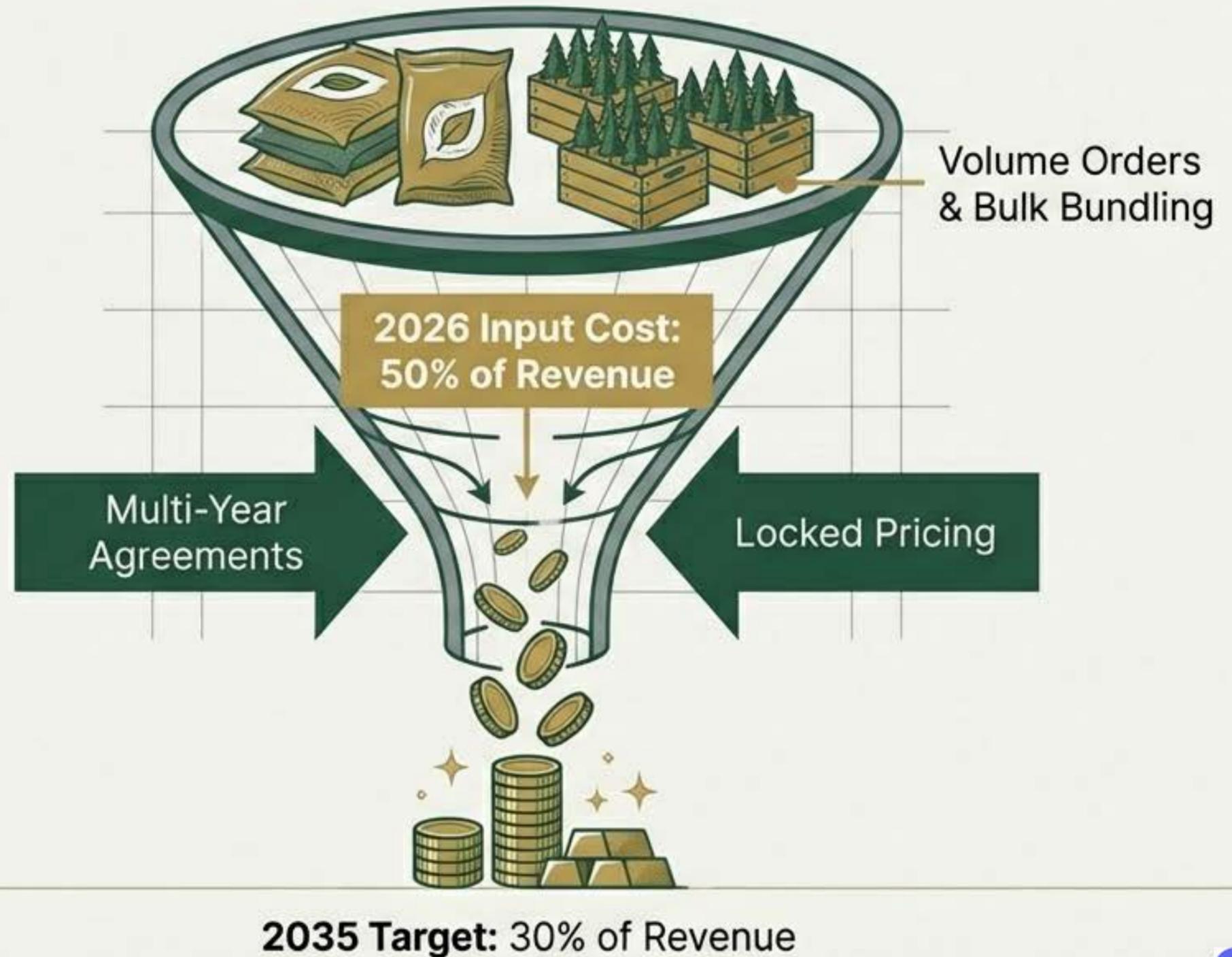
Strategy 2: Scaling to Absorb \$203,400 in Overhead



5 acres cannot support the fixed cost base. To dilute overhead, the operation must scale to 10 acres by 2028.

Strategy 3: Aggressive COGS Reduction

- Bundle seeding and fertilizer orders.
- Lock multi-year bulk pricing.
- Benchmark competitor input spend.



Strategy 4: Capping the Variable Cost Beast

Target: Reduce seasonal labor from 70% to 50% of revenue.



Strategic Fixes

- **Cross-Training:** Service staff assist cutting.
- **Surge Staffing:** +25% headcount for Dec 1-15.
- **Efficiency:** Removes revenue cap.

Strategy 5: The Retail & Concessions Multiplier

Margin Expansion

Investment:

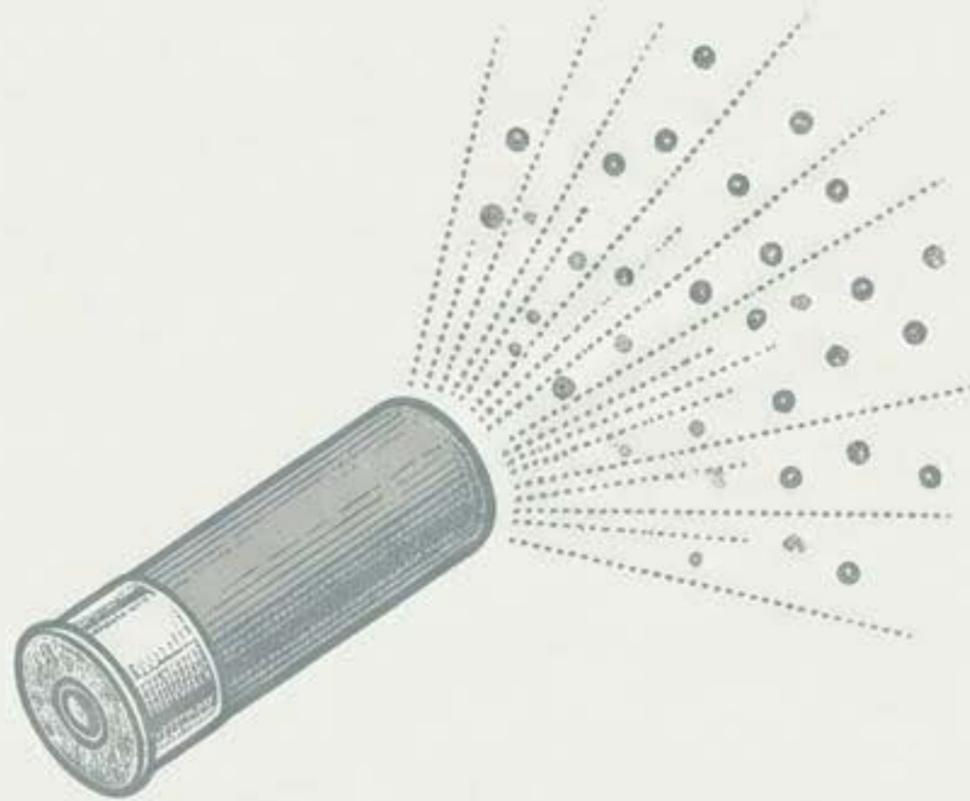
- Retail Manager Hire (2028)
- **Cost:** \$40,000 + Burden

ROI Target:

- +20% Average Transaction Value
- **Rationale:** Ancillary items have lower COGS than trees.

Strategy 6: Paying for Conversion, Not Reach

The Old Way: 40% Spend



Broad campaigns, low intent.

The New Way: 30% Spend



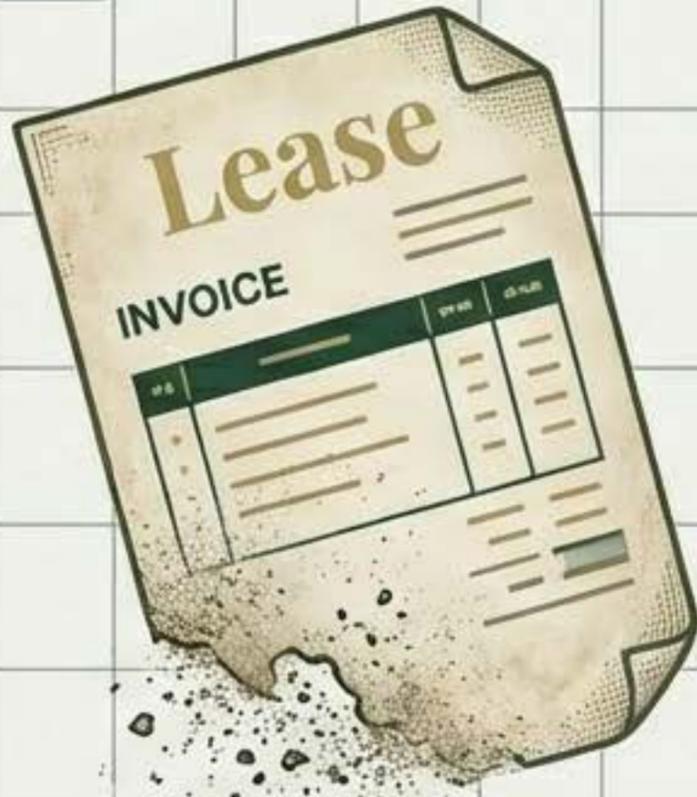
Geo-fencing, high-intent digital.

Requirement: 25% lift in conversion efficiency.

Outcome:
Frees capital for Retail Manager.

Strategy 7: Land Ownership vs. Leasing

The Trap



\$200/month. **Zero Equity. Inflation Risk.**

The Asset



\$15,000/year Investment (Starts 2030).

Turns a variable expense (rent) into a fixed asset (equity).

The Integrated Financial Model: 2026 vs. 2035



2026 Current State

- 5 Acres
- White Pines
- Leased Land
- 70% Labor Cost
- 50% Input COGS

Low Margin / High Risk

8 Years of
Capitalization



2035 Future State

- 10 Acres
- Fraser Firs
- Partial Ownership
- 50% Labor Cost
- 30% Input COGS

High Margin Equity

Implementation Timeline: Plan Definitely, Execute Honestly



The gap between a hobby farm and a strategic asset is 8 years of disciplined capitalization.
